

Three Workshops in Kyoto



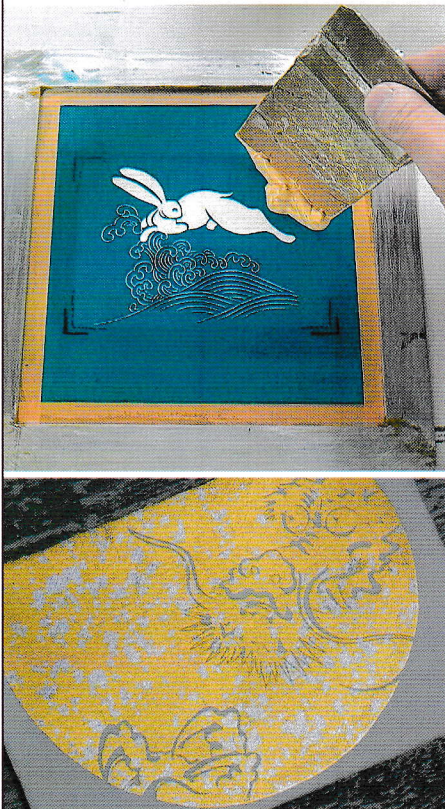
Know in Kyoto. Taste. Experience it. A deeper and more diverse "Nippon".

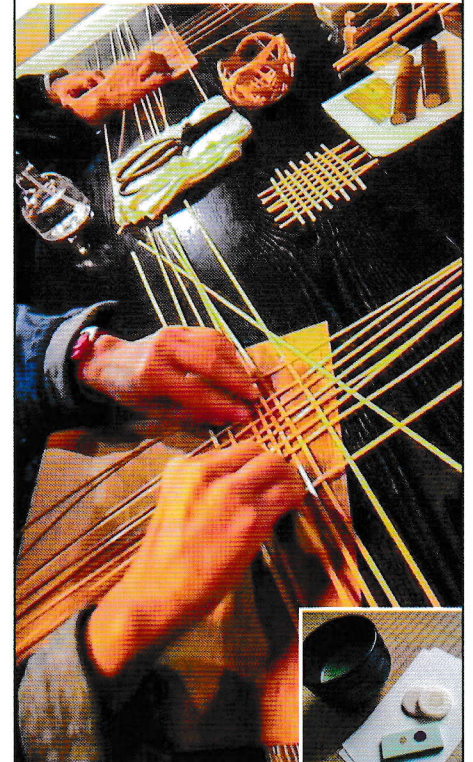

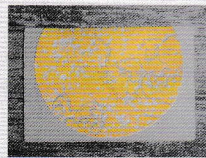
